**Crab mentality**, sometimes referred to as **crabs in the bucket**, is a phrase that describes a way of thinking best described by "if I can't have it, neither can you."

- The metaphor refers to a pot of crabs. Individually, the crabs could easily escape from the
  pot, but instead, they grab at each other in a useless "king of the hill" competition that
  prevents any from escaping and ensures their collective demise.
- The analogy in human behavior is that members of a group will attempt to "pull down" (negate or diminish the importance of) any member who achieves success beyond the others, out of envy, conspiracy, or competitive feelings.
